
2. The Terms of Reference to the Task Force for preparing Policy paper on 'Identity and Access Management' will be as follows:

- (a) Policy guidelines on Identity and Access Management will be based on the outcome of the two days summit on July 27-28, 2006 at NIC HQ, New Delhi.
- (b) Manage interaction with similar initiatives and standards bodies elsewhere in the world;
- (c) Policy to be product independent and based on Standards as far as possible.
- (d) Create a supporting framework for implementation and validation.
- (e) Identify materials to facilitate wide scale adoption
- (f) A quorum of group participants support any formal decision of the group.
- (g) Setting timeline for the release of initial policy to the Apex Body of Standards of DIT.
- (h) Identify project for immediate implementation to validate the document and refine based on feedback.
- (i) Policy revision based on feedback during the first year of implementation of the policy
- (j) Change control of the Draft policy document and Version Management.

3. This task force shall submit its draft policy document on Identity and Access Management by 25th December 2006.

4. TA/DA of non- official members for attending the meeting will be paid as admissible to Class I Officer of the Government of India as per SR 190 (a) . The expenditure on TA/DA of the Officials will be borne by the respective Central Ministry/Central Department /State Governments to which they belong.

5. The Task Force will be serviced by the E- Governance Standards Division of the National Informatics Centre.
